### Viksit Bharat Run, 2025

Organised by Embassy of India, Copenhagen and Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India

28 September 2025

The Embassy of India in Copenhagen, jointly with MY Bharat, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, successfully organised the **Viksit Bharat Run 2025 on 28 September 2025**. Held simultaneously across **over 150 international locations**, the event became a truly global celebration of service, fitness, and sustainability. The run in Copenhagen drew enthusiastic participation from the Indian diaspora, local communities, students, professionals, and friends of India.

The run was held as part of **Seva Pakhwada (17 September – 2 October)**, and reflected the transformative progress India has achieved in areas such as infrastructure, healthcare, technology, education, and sustainability under the leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. The community in city of Copenhagen reaffirmed its commitment to the Prime Minister's vision of **Viksit Bharat, a developed India**, by joining the run.

Under the theme "**Run to Serve the Nation**," participants from Copenhagen came together for community runs of **3-5 kilometres**, turning the event into a powerful statement of collectiveness. More than a fitness activity, the event celebrated the ideals of **Seva Bhav** (spirit of service) and echoed Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's vision of **Viksit Bharat @ 2047**. It also embodied India's **Swadeshi ethos**, highlighting the collective call for self-reliance, inclusivity, and environmental responsibility.

**Shri Dinesh Pratap Singh, Minister of State (IC) for Foreign Trade, Agricultural Exports, Marketing and Horticulture, UP Government** graced the occasion along with his delegation who has been visiting Denmark for taking part in the 49th APIMONDIA Congress and hold discussions with relevant stakeholders on agriculture and investment opportunities in the state of UP. **Mr Allan S. Andersen, Mayor of Tårnby Municipality** also graced the event, underscoring the importance of connecting India's development story with the world. **Shri Dinesh Pratap Singh, Hon'ble Minister, Mr Allan S. The turnout was remarkable, with around **200 runners, 10 volunteers**, and about **20 Indian community organisations** joining hands to make the event a grand success.

A key moment of the event was the collective recitation of the **Viksit Bharat and Aatmanirbhar Bharat Pledge**, where participants committed to contributing towards India's journey of becoming a developed nation by 2047. This gesture brought Copenhagen closer to Indians across the globe, aligning with the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's vision of a Viksit Bharat and reinforcing a shared aspiration for growth, innovation, and global leadership.
